

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Every piece is designed with meticulous attention to detail and built to stand the test of time. Follow these suggestions to preserve your piece for decades to come.

C L E A N I N G

Wipe with a soft, dry cloth.

For spills — use a slightly damp cloth with mild soap. Dry immediately.

Avoid harsh cleaners: alcohol, ammonia, silicone.

S U N L I G H T & H U M I D I T Y

Wood naturally changes color over time.

Avoid direct sunlight when possible.

Move objects occasionally to keep color even.

Ideal humidity: 35–50%

D A I L Y U S E

Use coasters — heat and moisture can leave marks.

Do not place rubber or plastic directly on the surface.

They may react with the finish and leave a mark.

Use felt pads to prevent scratches.

S H E L F & O U T L E T

Keep liquids away from the outlet area.

Do not overload the shelf.

R E P A I R & R E F R E S H

The oil finish allows local repair.

Clean → apply oil → wipe off.

No need to refinish the whole piece.
